

CALL FOR SERVICE PROVIDERS TO SUBMIT B-BBEE LEVEL CONTRIBUTOR CERTIFICATES

The new Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (PPPFA), from Government Gazette Regulations on 8 June 2011 (No.34350) and came into effect on 7 December 2011. These Regulations require service providers to submit original or certified copies of their B-BBEE Status Level Certificates for accredited verification agency.

Service providers that are currently registered on Tswelopele supplier's database are urged to submit their B-BBEE Status level Certificates in order to be captured as the vendor on the system and for verification and approval.

Tswelopele Local Municipality is expected to comply with the legal framework from 7 December 2011 and the 80/20 and 90/10 preference point will be applied according to the formula and the applicable points as provided in respect of Status Levels Contributor Tables in the regulations. Failure to submit the B-BBEE Status level Certificates will lead a zero status level for non-Compliant service providers or contributors.

Service providers not yet registered on Tswelopele database are encouraged to collect database forms from Tswelopele Local Municipality Offices.
