Primary Health Care Services for Bultfontein community



On 16 March 2012 the new DA Maleho clinic in Bultfontein, was officially opened by the FS Premier, Mr Ace Magashule. The clinic is named after Ms Suzan Maleho, a well-known and beloved midwife and community worker over many years in Bultfontein and Phahameng. A family member of Ms Maleho assisted Mr Magashule. He said: "Please look after your clinic and be proud of it by taking care of it."

Ms Alida Zwiendelaar, Lejweleputswa District Health Director, informed the community that "the clinic will render a full comprehensive service, you can get the ARVs, babies immunisation and anything that is needed. The clinic will be used for Primary Health Care (PHC) re-engineering and outreach to the communities."



Services at DA Maleho Clinic:

Immunisation; Childhood Illnesses; Chronic Illnesses / Minor Ailments; Antenatal / Post Natal Care; Reproductive Health; Confidential Counseling & Testing; Sexually Transmitted Infections; HIV and AIDS Services; Mental Health; Rehabilitation Services; Tuberculosis; Communicable Diseases; Youth Health Services; Geriatric Services; Oral Health; School Health Services; Health Promotion.

The MEC for Health, Ms Fezi Ngubentombi thanked God for the opportunity to open the new MA Maleho Clinic. She also said: "We have been sent here by the government under the leadership of our President, Jacob Zuma and the Minister of Health, Dr Aaron Motsoaledi, who tabled the strategy to bring health services to the people, by indicating that the people must be able to live and to fight non-communicable and communicable diseases; to fight the maternal infant mortality rate in the province and to strengthen the health services through the Primary Health Care (PHC) re-engineering."
